## **Clayton Hall Academy**

### **Changes to Behaviour Policy whilst social distancing is necessary during the current COVID-19 pandemic**

**(To be read in conjunction with our Behaviour Policy)**

In light of the need for children to behave differently when they return to school, new systems have been implemented and therefore our Academy's Behaviour Policy has been adapted to support these systems. As well as being documented within the Behaviour Policy, these changes will also be communicated to students, parents and staff.

On return to school all students are expected to maintain our Gold Standard Behaviour and:

- To maintain the 2 metre social distancing rules at all times.
- To follow any altered routines for arrival or departure to the academy.
- To follow school instructions on hygiene, such as handwashing and sanitising.
- To follow instructions on who they can socialise with at school.
- To follow instructions and remain in allocated Rainbow Groups and Rooms.
- To move around the school following the specific designated routes for their group.
- To follow the expectations about sneezing, coughing, tissues and disposal ('catch it, bin it, kill it') and avoiding touching their mouth, nose and eyes with hands.
- To tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus.
- To follow rules that no items or equipment should be shared.
- To remain in designated groups and areas at social times.
- To follow the procedure for the use of the toilets (1 in 1 out system)

It is crucial that the behaviour of students respects the need to minimise the spread of the disease. Therefore, failing to follow the expectations will result in removal from school site.

#### **Students working at home**

Students should ensure that they are using the online resources and email system responsibly and follow the school code of conduct for computer use. Misuse of this system will potentially result in access being removed.

#### **Sanctions**

If a student fails to follow the guidelines above, in order to protect the staff and other students within the school, it will be necessary for the school to issue a Fixed Term Exclusion. The student will be removed from the classroom or area they are in, their parents/carers will

be contacted, and they will be asked to leave the premises. This will remain on the students' files. Repeated failure to follow the school expectations could lead to further sanctions and possibly Permanent Exclusion.

**Rewards**

The academy will continue to reward students as much as possible in a variety of ways during this time.
